My Great, Great Grandad, Ben Matthews World War 1 Experience.

Ben Matthews was born on 28/12/1893, and died on 15/04/1979.

His first job was as a gardener, working in the Carnation Greenhouses on a large country Estate. My Nana can't remember if this was in France, or in England.

Then he joined the army and fought in World War 1. He survived so many battles that he was called 'Lucky Ben' and other soldiers wanted to be with him. He was a Corporal Sergeant Major of the D.Corps. 1<sup>st</sup> Queen's Royal West Surrey's.

The battles he fought in were the Battle of Verdun, The Battle of the Somme, the Battle of Mons and the Ypres Campaign.

He had to return home when he received a 'blighty' (when a piece of metal went through his helmet and in to his head. He was fine once his head had healed up.

Once the War was over he returned to live in Chiswick in London, and became a Policeman. He patrolled the streets of London.


