



EXAM RESULTS SUMMER 2020 – GCSE RESULTS DAY INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS

Under normal circumstances we would invite you to come into school to collect your results and celebrate with your peers, Teachers and Tutors. Unfortunately, this year, we have been requested by Public Health Northamptonshire to consider alternative options for the issuing of GCSE and A level results to continue to minimise the risk of transmission of the coronavirus.

Please therefore see below the arrangements for this year.

GCSE Results will be emailed to student's school email addresses from 8:00am on the 20th August. 8:00am is the time set by JCQ for release of results to candidates.

It is our policy to only send results directly to the candidate and we will not give out results over the telephone. If the candidate wishes to make alternative email address arrangements, then they must notify the Exams Office at exams@hattonacademy.org.uk

For those of you who have not achieved in-line with expectations we will have members of the Senior Leadership Team on-site to offer support & guidance. To access this support please email sixthforminfo@hattonacademy.org.uk so that we can arrange a one-to-one appointment for you to discuss your options on results day itself. Alternatively, you may be contacted on results day by a member of the Senior Leadership Team to discuss your results with you. Post Results/Exam Entry Requests

Information on post results services, including requests for submitted grades and the appeals process, will be available from Results Day onwards. Please be aware that the post results services are significantly different from previous years due to the Centre Assessed Grades procedure.



Should you wish to avail of the opportunity to improve your exam grade by sitting GCSE examinations in the Autumn 2020 series, a digital request form will be sent with your results. Deadlines for requests will be indicated on the forms. Any requests submitted after these deadlines may not be accepted due to exam board deadlines for entries. Please consult with teaching staff and/or a member of the Senior Leadership Team before submitting your request.

Exam Certificates

Certificates are normally received from the Awarding Bodies towards the end of the first week in November. When received, all the certificates are collated into envelopes - one for each candidate and made available for collection. This is generally in the first week of December. Please note, we cannot post certificates. Students should collect them in person. If this is not possible, you may nominate a person to collect on your behalf by emailing the details of the person authorised to collect for you. This must be done at least 24 hours before collection is to be made. The person nominated to collect on your behalf will also need to provide a form of Identification (passport, licence, Utility Bill).
