Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

I hope this letter finds you well. We are writing to inform you about an update to our Academy 'Behaviour for Life' and 'Uniform Policy' (these can be found attached). The changes to the Behaviour for Life Policy will take place at the start of the spring term in January.

These changes have been made as a result of feedback from parents, staff and students and aim to enhance the overall learning environment at the Academy, whilst promoting a sense of belonging among students. We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring that your child adheres to the expectations outlined in these policies.

In addition to the update of the Behaviour for Life Policy, we are also making a key change to our Uniform Processes which will take effect from Monday 4th December. In order to ensure that all students are 'Dressed for Excellence', we will be asking students to borrow uniform that they are missing or have forgotten. To ensure this uniform is returned to us, we will ask students to swap a piece of uniform for a personal item, for example a mobile phone. When the students return the piece of uniform at the end of the day, we will return their personal item. If this item is not returned, we will ask parents or carers to pay for replacements.

We will be informing students of these changes in assemblies along with our expectations and the consequences if they breach any of these expectations before the end of this term.

If a child refuses to adhere to these consequences, then as outlined in our policy students will be subjected to an escalation of sanctions which may result in a suspension.
