Dear Parents and Carers,

As we move into the summer term we are writing to remind you and your child of our uniform expectations (full details of our uniform policy can be found by following this <u>link</u>). In particular we would like to draw your attention to the following:

- Academy blazer with embroidered Academy crest. Students should enter the Academy site with their blazer on. Students are required to have their blazer on as they enter every lesson. Students may remove blazers during social times and can ask for permission to remove their blazer in the lesson during hot weather.
- Black smart, straight (including pencil) or A-line skirt that is on or below the knee in length. A minority of students sometimes choose to adjust their skirts that would otherwise meet this policy to wear them above the knee. Students must adjust their skirts to be at least knee length at all times. If wearing skirts of a material that rides up when sitting down students must take responsibility for adjusting their skirt to at least knee length as they stand. If students choose to wear skirts above knee length at any point during the day, even if the skirt can be adjusted when requested, a sanction will be imposed for not being Dressed for Excellence. Whilst most students are wearing their uniform correctly, we are still having a few challenges with some skirt lengths which do not meet our expectations. After the Easter break any students who arrives at the Academy with skirts that do not meet our expectations will be placed in RESET.

## **Jewellery**

Students are permitted to wear following items of jewellery:

- Two small studs may be worn in each ear
- One nose stud may be worn
- Hoop earrings (of any size) and dangly earrings are not permitted
- One necklace may be worn however it must be kept inside the shirt collar and must not be visible
- One small ring may be worn on each hand
- One watch and one bracelet may be worn

We once again want to thank you for your ongoing support as we ensure all students achieve excellence.
